A first-generation Mage candidate with intense anxiety learns that students asking for disability accommodations are disappearing—quite literally—in this dark academia fantasy novel that combines the whimsical studies of Emily Wilde's *Encyclopedia of Fairies* with the academic setting and themes of *Babel: or the Necessity of Violence*.

First generation Mage candidate Bartleby has one more chance to pass her Branch & Field exam or else she will lose access to the higher-level magic afforded by her university. Still reeling from the paralyzing anxiety that made her freeze on her first attempt, she is horrified when her advisor "suggests" that she reframe her entire dissertation through a Digimancy framework, historically her worst subject. And, after her working goes horribly wrong, Bartleby inadvertently creates a talking skull who narrates her inner thoughts like she's a heroine in an Austen novel. Not sure what else to do, Bartleby names the skull "Anne."

Facing the scrutiny of her professors, increasingly frequent panic attacks, and the impending deadline of her exam, Bartleby begins to buckle under pressure and doubts whether she is fit to become a Mage at all. Needing help, Bartleby recruits James, an unfairly attractive fellow Mage candidate, to discern the reason for Anne's glitches and correct the code in time for her exam. Instead, Anne leads them to a shocking and dangerous discovery: students who seek disability accommodations are literally disappearing off campus without a trace. And when the administration fails to act, Bartleby must learn to trust in her knowledge and skills or else risk losing both the missing students and her future as a Mage, permanently.

AUTHOR BIO: Courtney Floyd is a neurodivergent fantasy author who grew up in New Mexico, where she learned to write between tarantula turf wars and apocalyptic dust storms. She currently lives at the bottom of a haunted mountain in the woods of Vermont with her partner and pets. Courtney has a PhD in British Literature and a penchant for irreverent literary allusions. But their stories haven't really been told—and the repercussions of that exclusion shape the outdoor world, too.





Ten years ago, therapist Jonathan Alpert warned in the *New York Times* about the dangers of too much therapy—a growing self-obsession that has led to overdiagnosing, overmedication, and a "new normal" of narcissism. In the intervening years, Alpert argues in THE THERAPY TRAP, so many of his colleagues have lost the point of their profession, becoming crutches instead of counselors. It's a good thing that mental health care has become destignatized over the years, but now we have entered into a period of overcorrection, with a new "therapy culture" taking root.

Alpert's early warning was prescient. Shortly after his controversial *New York Times* op-ed was published, a Johns Hopkins study found that 60% percent of people who had been previously diagnosed with major depressive disorder did not actually meet the criteria for it. And things don't seem to be getting any better. A 2021 study found "convincing evidence" that "ADHD is overdiagnosed in children and adolescents." Another study noted a massive 123% increase in adult ADHD diagnoses between 2007 and 2016. This year The *New York Times* reported that prescriptions for ADHD surged during the Covid pandemic, notably among women, by as much as 81% for women aged 20-39.

The therapy trap is a real danger to a functioning society, Alpert maintains. Instead of helping patients become more comfortable in the world around them—even if that means challenging them—it is now far too common for therapists to provide endless validation feedback loops, which ends up encouraging patients to silo themselves off from anything that provides even the slightest disturbance to their mood at any point. That makes it nearly impossible for patients to live in a community of varied viewpoints, experiences, and perspectives — whether that be a family or a workplace. The cumulative effect of this is the sense of atomization that we feel all around us, in so many aspects of life.

Our popular culture and even daily life have become inundated with "therapy-speak," specific terms that have escaped from the therapist's office into the wider discourse without any of their clinical, scientific context. Words like "toxic," "gaslighting" and "boundaries" have been weaponized and used as cudgels in everyday conversation. One survey found that 80% of women and 74% percent of men would label at least one of their friends as "toxic."
