Sebastian Fitzek is THE most successful German bestselling author, whose works have sold more than 19 million copies and have been published in more than 37 countries. He began his career in radio, later studying law and gaining a doctorate in copyright law. In 2006, he published his first psychological thriller *Therapy*, which became a bestseller, as did all subsequent books. Between 2014 and 2021, Sebastian Fitzek was the most successful German author of the year six times. In 2023, his books The Invitation and Parent's Eve were the best-selling books of the year. Many of his books have been successfully adapted for film and television series, such as Therapy (Prime Video) as a six-part mini-series, which was a TOP 10 hit in seventeen countries for several weeks. Also, many of his works have been the subject of several theater adaptations, including Soulbreaker, Therapy and Passenger 23. Sebastian Fitzek has twice been nominated for the Glauser Prize and has been awarded the Golden Lovelybooks Readers' Prize several times. He also received the Hörkules and won the European Prize for Crime Literature in 2016. 


















Markus Heitz

Markus Heitz, born in 1971, studied German Philology and History.

With his series *The Dwarves*, he achieved a national and international breakthrough; the books were translated into numerous languages and spent weeks on the bestseller lists. His fantasy novels were joined by successful thrillers about werewolfs, vampires, soul walkers and other dark figures of (urban) fantasy. He has now written over 60 novels, which have been translated into 17 languages – his name being on the bestseller lists without interruption for years. After studying 'Journalism and German Studies', Oliver Kalkofe began his career in 1991 at the radio station ffn with the cult format Frühstyxradio. He quickly became one of the best-known audiobook and dubbing voices in Germany thanks to his versatile vocal talent and has lent his voice to countless film and television characters. Oliver Kalkofe's passion for film led him to write the screenplays for the successful cinema films 'Der Wixxer' and 'Neues vom Wixxer', in which he also played a leading role himself.

In his Grimme Award-winning programme 'Kalkofes Mattscheibe', he has been showing the most absurd scenes on German television for almost 30 years and satirising them in his own special humorous way.











Uwe Laub
