An adorable picture book about inclusion and diversity

Mila joins a new kindergarten and gets on very well if no barriers are put in her way. The other children quickly realize that a little creativity is needed so that everyone can play together, and the trip to the zoo is a success despite the broken elevator. Together with her new friends, Mila even manages to rebuild the local playground so that all the children can really enjoy it. A cheerful story about friendship and how easy it is to overcome obstacles when working together.

Prominent voice for inclusion: Kristina Vogel, Olympic track cyclist and wheelchair user since a training accident, is a high-profile advocate for accessibility and for raising awareness in society

This insight into the world of a child in a wheelchair shows even the youngest children how barriers can be broken down and how to overcome inhibitions when interacting with people with disabilities

Kristina Vogel is the most successful sprinter in the world with two Olympic victories and 17 world championship titles in track cycling. Since a training accident in 2018, she has been involved in social and political initiatives for accessibility and works as a trainer for the German Federal Police. She is active as a TV expert at numerous sporting events. She wants to break down barriers – both in everyday life and in people's minds.

Lily Baron is a designer and graphic artist with many years of professional experience in the international fashion industry. This was where she designed her first characters and developed her ability to tell stories in a single image.

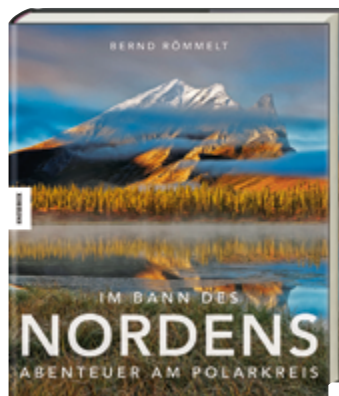
